PRAYERS for THE LORD'S SUPPER

Understanding the Lord's Supper: The Lord's Supper, also known as Communion, is the family meal of Christians. If you have repented of your sins and look to Jesus as your only hope, this meal is for you. It is not so much a declaration of your commitment to God, as it is his commitment to you. If you do not identify as Christian, we encourage you to feel no pressure to partake of something that is not reflective of your own spiritual journey.

Prayer of Searching: God, if you are real and you love me, please let me know you are there. I want to trust you, but I need to be persuaded. Open my mind and my heart that I might believe in you. If Jesus is who he claimed to be, then give me faith. Amen.

Prayer of Belief: Jesus, I admit that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever before believed, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dared hope. I need you to forgive me. I need you to heal me. I need you to change me. I give up trusting in myself, and I put my life in your hands. Thank you for dying so that I might live. I receive you today. Amen.

Prayer of Renewal: Jesus, you are the source of all blessing in this life. As I eat this bread and drink this cup, renew me in the joy of knowing and following you. Help me to turn from every false satisfaction to feed on you, the true and living bread. As you have completely and fully offered yourself for me, I now completely and fully offer myself to you. Amen.
